Re: Social Media Policy

The following policy has been adopted by Gold Coast JRL Executive and comes into operation immediately.

Please ensure all club committee members, players, team staff, volunteers and officials are aware of this policy.

GOLD COAST JRL Social Networking Site Policy (effective 20th March 2013)

Any player or official who is found to have improperly used any social networking site including Facebook, YouTube or Twitter which concerns Rugby League in general or Gold Coast JRL in particular, may be brought before the Disciplinary Tribunal.

Improper use of social networking site includes:

- a) Insulting any person involved in Gold Coast JRL including but not limited to all on field match officials and players.
- b) Partaking in bullying any person involved in Gold Coast JRL by making offensive, racist, sexist, or abusive comments about a person or
- c) Engaging in any other behaviour that the Gold Coast JRL Executive decides in its discretion is improper use of social networking site or brings the game of Rugby League into disrepute.
